At Riverwood Center, we work with each person to help them find and keep a job that matches their strengths, interests, and goals. Our focus is not on changing who someone is, but on helping them find the right fit for their skills and experiences.

Supported Employment services are personalized and ongoing, with support designed to help individuals build confidence, gain independence, and succeed at work and in daily life.

Integrated Care

People who take part in Supported Employment at Riverwood Center can earn income, build confidence, and work toward greater independence. They also receive support through integrated care services.

Employment Specialists work closely with each person's care team, including care managers, psychiatrists, and other providers, to help support both employment and wellness goals. By combining mental health support with job coaching, Riverwood Center helps individuals succeed at work and in everyday life.

Eligibility

Everyone is eligible to be referred for Supported Employment, no one is excluded.

Individuals are not prevented from participating, regardless of their psychiatric diagnosis, symptoms, work history, or other concerns.

Equal Wages and Benefits

Supported Employment helps individuals find jobs that pay competitive wages, similar to other jobs in Berrien County. The focus is on competitive employment with client choice, attention to worker preferences, personalized benefits counseling, rapid job search, and time-unlimited, personalized support.

Employees may also receive benefits like health insurance and paid time off, making their work experience rewarding and stable. Supported Employment ensures that people not only find meaningful work but also enjoy the same benefits as others in the workforce.
